Range Rules

Any violation of the Range Rules will result in your immediate removal from the range without refund.

- 1. FIREARMS MUST ONLY BE HANDLED AND LOADED WITHIN THE SHOOTING STALL!!!!!
- 2. Do not handle firearms behind the firing line.
- 3. All firearms must be cased, bagged or holstered when approaching or leaving the shooting stall.
- 4. Treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- 5. Keep the firearm pointed down range at all times.
- 6. Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 7. Be aware of where your bullets are striking down range targets too low or too high will strike the floor or baffles instead of the trap.
- 8. All rifles must be fired with target at 25 yards.
- 9. No rapid fire. A minimum of 1 second is required between rounds.
- 10. Deliberate destruction of range equipment or property will result in a LIFETIME BAN.
- Eye and ear protection is required before entering and while on the range.
- 12. Never consume alcohol or use drugs before or while shooting.
- 13. Food, drinks and tobacco use of any kind is prohibited while on the range.
- 14. Only one shooter at a time, max 3 people per lane.
- 15. No one may go forward of the firing line for any reason.
- 16. You may collect your brass ONLY. If it in front of the firing line or in an occupied lane, it is LOST.
- 17. When you hear the command "CEASE FIRE", stop shooting immediately, put firearm on safe, lay it on the shooting bench and step behind the firing line.
- 18. BDC Gun Room, Inc. assumes no liability for lost or stolen property.
- 19. Any persons under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times.
- 20. Any persons under the age of 21 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times while handling or shooting a handgun.
- 21. If you observe any unsafe conditions or behavior, report them to the Range Safety Officer immediately.
